

## The Mystery of Wire Crochet Beadology Lake Geneva

### Wire Crochet Instructions....For Wire Crochet Bead Kits

Wire Crochet Bead Kits include: Designer selected bead combination, 1 roll of 28 gauge wire, and clasp.

Use a G or H Crochet Hook-not included in each kit.

1. Place all beads onto wire in a random pattern to about 2 ½ feet
2. To start do 3 chains of wire. Slide down a few beads (Bundle), open up loop, chain over bundle, and do 2 more chains. You will repeat this many times until you run out of bead bundles. You are creating a long rope that will be approximately. 6 to 10 feet long.
3. To end the rope, chain over the last bundle and do 3 more chains. Cut wire and pull thru to knot wire to end.
4. Gently pull on the rope to even out chain loops.
5. Measure length of rope to know how much you have. Decide on length and style of necklace with this measurement. Please note that the length of the rope is affected by how many beads you place on the wire, to how many beads are bundled together, to how many chains you decide to put between bundles.
6. Cut lengths and create tails to wire wrap around toggle and clasp. For example: if you are creating a 4 strand 16" necklace, you need to cut the lengths a little extra so you can back out the wire at the ends to create the tail to wrap.
7. Lay lengths together. Then lay last chain on top of each other. Twist for ½ inch. Place toggle on to wires, fold to ¼ inch and wrap 3 times. Cut off extra wire. Repeat for other side and use the bar.
8. You are done! Try it on and admire your beautiful creation!
